

LOCATION

Parents and their children study in the same location in our Kensington school, opposite Gloucester Road Station, or nearby annexe within walking



Children of ages 6-16 are accepted. In summer, a parent or guardian of a 6 year old must also take a course. At other times of the year they must either take a course or remain in the school during lesson times. The minimum age for adult in charge is 21.



PRIVATE LESSONS & MINI GROUPS

Family Junior Morning
