EU Students

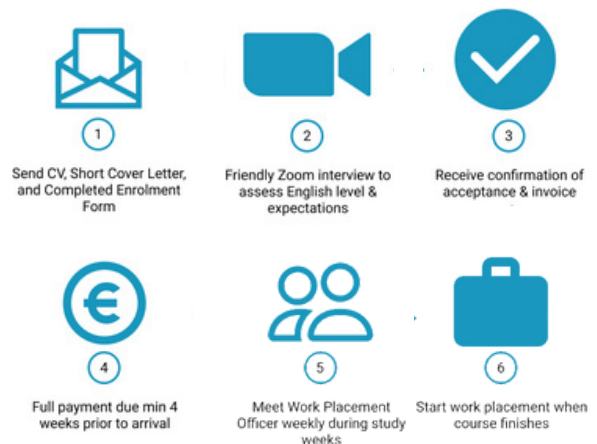
Our English + Work Placement Programme for EU students guarantees a paid work placement in the Dublin service sector. Placements of minimum 12 weeks are in bars, restaurants, cafes, shops, supermarkets, hotels etc

This unique programme allows students to utilise their newly acquired English skills in a working environment, something that proves invaluable to enhance their CVs and future employment opportunities.

- Students must be willing to accept all reasonable placement arrangements, concessions or requests for specific industries, positions, working times or pay rates cannot be accepted
- Minimum number of hours of paid employment is 15 hours per week (Average 20+)
- Minimum duration of the employment period 12 weeks (6 weeks summer)

Who can Participate?

- Students who want to improve their overall English language proficiency
- Students who are flexible and have a positive 'can do' attitude
- Students who want to work in the service sector in Dublin
- Students who want real-life paid experience, working in a real company and putting their new-found English language skills to use
- Students who are able to be in Dublin for a min of 16 weeks (min 4 weeks lessons and min 12 weeks placement)
- Students who are 18+





Minimum Age: 18
Course Length: Min 4 weeks*
Start Day: Any Monday

Placement: Minimum 12 weeks (6 weeks summer)
Min Wage (2025): €13.50 per hour (Aged 20+) €10.80 (Aged 18+)

This programme is particularly suited to students who are flexible, highly motivated, reliable, and present themselves in a professional manner. Depending on students' language level on completion of a pre-arrival interview, they will be advised as to the correct length of study required prior to the start of their paid employment in the Dublin service sector.

What type of jobs are available?

All jobs are in the Dublin service sector, this includes bars, restaurants, cafes, supermarkets, delis, shops etc. Recent students have gained employment in famous companies such as The Guinness Storehouse and COS clothing store.

What is the minimum hourly pay in Ireland?

Age group Minimum hourly rate:

- 18 years old: €10.80 per hour.
- 19 years old: €12.15 per hour.
- 20 years and over: €13.50 per hour.
